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MEDICATIONS TO STOP BEFORE SURGERY

10 days before surgery _____

- Aspirin (Bufferin, ASA, Ecotrin, Bayer)

7 days before surgery _____

- Plavix
- Ibuprofen (Motrin, Advil, Midol, Nuprin, Pamprin)
- Naprosyn (Aleve, Naproxen, Anaprox)
- Indocin
- Mobic
- Voltaren
- Relafen
- Any Herbal Supplements
- Vitamins (Multivitamin and Vitamin E, C, K, etc...)

5 days before surgery _____

- Coumadin (need blood test on morning of surgery)

You may continue to take _____

- Tylenol
- Celebrex
- Ultram/Ultracet (tramadol)
- Vicodin (hydrocodone)
