



Total Hip Arthroplasty Medication Schedule

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Please Note:

- Use the Vicodin/Norco as medicine for severe or breakthrough pain. It can be taken every 4 hours as needed. In the first 5-7 days, we recommend taking this medicine regularly.
- Take the Xarelto 10 mg for 3 weeks after the surgery. If on a blood thinner pre-operatively, this will be continued post-operatively.
- In order to provide an optimal environment for bone ingrowth into your prostheses please refrain from taking NSAIDs (anti-inflammatory agents) for 6 weeks.
- Continue the Senekot-S/colace as long as you take any of the pain medicines (Vicodin/Norco or Oxycontin).
- Please follow the taper schedule prescribed for the Oxycontin.
- Keep in mind that when you start to decrease your Oxycontin dose, you will find an increase in your Vicodin/Norco usage.
- Plan to wean off of narcotic medications by 3 weeks after surgery; however, it is not uncommon to take a Vicodin dose in the evening for up to 6 weeks after surgery.
